

CONGREGATIONAL MEETING MINUTES  
FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH  
NOVEMBER 12, 2017

The congregation of First Presbyterian Church of Greenville, North Carolina, held a meeting at 10:50 AM on November 12, 2017, in the Sanctuary. The purpose of the meeting was to act on a report from the Nominating Committee and to act on the request of Bill Neely to dissolve his pastoral relationship with First Presbyterian Church.

Moderator Bill Neely called the meeting to order and declared a quorum present. Clerk of Session, Dick Marks, served as clerk for the meeting. Moderator Neely led the gathering in an opening prayer.

Emily Coffman, representing the 2017 Nominating Committee, made a motion on behalf of the committee that the following nominees be elected.

**Nominee for Elder, Class of 2018,** to fill an unexpired term: Jeri Jackson

**Nominee for Trustee, class of 2020:** Debra Mizelle

After there were no nominations from the floor, the motion passed, and these members were elected by acclamation.

Ms. Coffman then made a motion on behalf of the committee that the following members be elected to serve as congregational representatives to the 2018 Nominating Committee: Peggy Barnes, Kathy Howard, David Kemble, John Morrow, and Tammy Worden. After there were no nominations from the floor, the motion passed, and these members were elected by acclamation.

The Moderator then recognized the Clerk of Session, Dick Marks, who made a motion on behalf of the Session that the congregation agree to the request from the Pastor that the pastoral relationship between the Rev. Dr. William K. Neely and First Presbyterian Church, Greenville be dissolved, effective December 31, 2017. After a moment allowing for any questions, the motion passed.

With no further business, the Moderator adjourned the meeting with prayer.
